

## State of Colorado Motor Vehicle Bill of Sale For Purged Colorado Record

This procedure is completed when the vehicle has been titled in Colorado, the vehicle is physically located in Colorado and the Colorado motor vehicle record has been purged. The owner may:

- Sell the vehicle or
- Re-establish the ownership document

## State of Colorado Motor Vehicle Bill of Sale For Purged Colorado Record Checklist

Step	What You Need To Do	Forms/Fees
<b>1</b>	<p>Have the vehicle inspected and the "Verification of Vehicle Identification Number" completed by one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Licensed Colorado emission inspection station</li> <li>• Licensed Colorado automobile dealer</li> <li>• Colorado law enforcement officer</li> <li>• Colorado county motor vehicle office</li> </ul> <p>For manufactured homes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• County Assessor</li> <li>• Manufactured home dealer</li> </ul>	DR 2698
<b>2</b>	<p><b>Provide one of the following acceptable ownership documents.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Colorado registration</li> <li>• Colorado renewal card</li> <li>• Photocopy of Colorado title document</li> <li>• Verification from the county (Copy of county's record)</li> <li>• For manufactured homes, verification from the county treasurer/assessor that it has been in the owner's name and on the tax rolls for the past 10 years. The verification must include the vehicle identification number and the Colorado title number</li> </ul> <p>If there are no proper ownership documents, title must be established by one of the following procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Title or Salvage Title Established by Surety Bond, see DR 2922</li> <li>• In Lieu of Bond for Manufactured Homes 25 Years old, see DR 2463</li> <li>• In Lieu of Bond for Motor Vehicles 25 Years Old or Older, see DR 2462</li> </ul>	
<b>3</b>	<p>Apply for <b>Title</b> at the county motor vehicle office in the county in which you live.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Manufactured homes are titled at the county motor vehicle office in the county in which the manufactured home is located.</li> </ul> <p>Secure and Verifiable Identification is required to obtain a title and/or registration in the state of Colorado. Please see DR 2841 for acceptable identification documents.</p> <p><b>**NOTE**</b> The odometer must be disclosed on a secure form for motor vehicles with model year of less than 10 years. The applicant taking title will disclose the mileage on the DR 2173 Motor Vehicle Bill of Sale.
